This overall Privacy Statement discloses the privacy practices for the entire MavenTree website. Our company collects personal information about our users during usage of our service. We respect your right to privacy. As part of the process, we give you the opportunity to decline to receive any mailings from either MavenTree or other parties to whom MavenTree may provide such information.

Information Collection and Use

MavenTree is the sole owner of the information voluntarily given to us by the users of this site. We will not sell, share, or rent this information to others in ways different from what is disclosed in this statement. MavenTree collects information from our users at several different points on our website. The data we collect from cookies and other places is used in the aggregate to give us demographic information about the entire MavenTree audience in order to improve the MavenTree service. The personal information you provide - name, email address, etc. -- allows us to inform you about updates to the service and to notify you of products and services of MavenTree, its affiliates and third parties that we believe may be of interest to you. We also share aggregate information -- not individual data -- with our advertisers to help them better understand our services and to monitor the reach of their advertising on the service.

Notification of Changes
